



Proper Maintenance Instructions for Outdoor Padding



Follow these tips and tricks to help prolong the life of your outdoor padding products:

- Keep the vinyl clean from dirt or foreign materials to help protect against mildew.
- Clean the vinyl with a mixture of warm water and soap.
- Do not use any cleaning products that contain chlorine or bleach. This may cause discoloration to the vinyl or deterioration.
- Hand wash the pads when required. If necessary use a brush with soft bristles or a sponge to remove a stain.
- Do not use a pressure washer as this may destroy the surface of the vinyl.
- Thoroughly rinse the pads after they are cleaned to remove soap residue.
- Inspect for holes and tears in the vinyl often.
- Verify pads are securely fastened to their attachments on a regular basis.
- Since the pads are installed outside, due to direct sunlight the vinyl color may fade after years of being exposed to UV rays. This is common throughout the industry and should not be viewed as a warranty issue.
- Cover the pads if fertilizers, insecticides or similar products are being used to prevent overspray.
